Adam B. Green, 38, of Peoria, passed away on Wednesday, February 14, 2024, at OSF St. Francis Medical Center in Peoria. He was born in Bloomington on October 1, 1985, to Bradley and Shelia (Adams) Green. He is survived by his parents of Ft. Myers Beach, FL, his grandfather, Richard Green, of Ft.
