Aleene (Giebelhausen) Geier, 91, of East Peoria, passed away at Lutheran Hill Village on July 14, 2021, at 3:30 AM. She was born on March 5, 1930, to Adolf and Gertrude (Schoedel) Giebelhausen in Peoria. She married Daniel Geier on October 28, 1950, at The Cathedral of Saint Mary of the Immaculate Conception in Peoria; he preceded her in death in October 2001.
