

## Daryle G. Ball

August 26, 1939 - June 23, 2021

Daryle G. Ball, 81, of East Peoria, passed away on Wednesday, June 23, 2021 at OSF St. Francis Medical Center in Peoria. He was born on August 26, 1939 to Harvey and Della (Booker) Ball in Greeneville, TN. 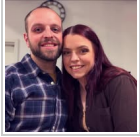
