David enjoyed being outdoors, mowing yards, and was a fan of the Seattle Seahawks and the comic hero, Superman.

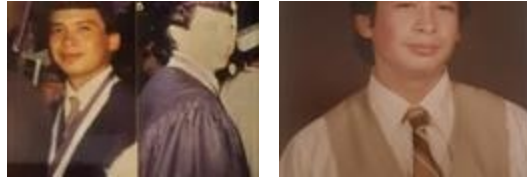
Cremation rites have been accorded Gary Deiters Funeral Home & Cremation Services in East Peoria is assisting the family.
