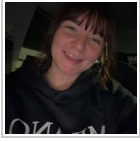
She had so much artistic talent and participated regularly in art classes locally. She was truly a light in this world and will be remembered as such.

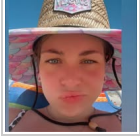

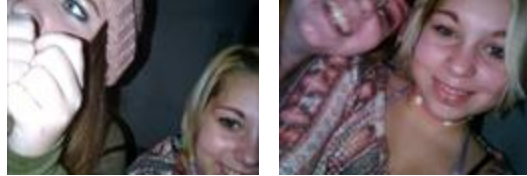
