Jackie Hunt II, 55, of Peoria, passed away, surrounded by family, on Sunday, December 15, 2024, at his home. He was born in Peoria on November 21, 1969, to Jackie D. “Jack” and Bonnie (Simpson) Hunt. He married Stephanie “Nicki” Gluck on May 6, 2017, in Peoria; she survives.

He will always hold a special place in my heart. He was my family, and I know we will see each other again in the afterlife.

May he rest in peace.

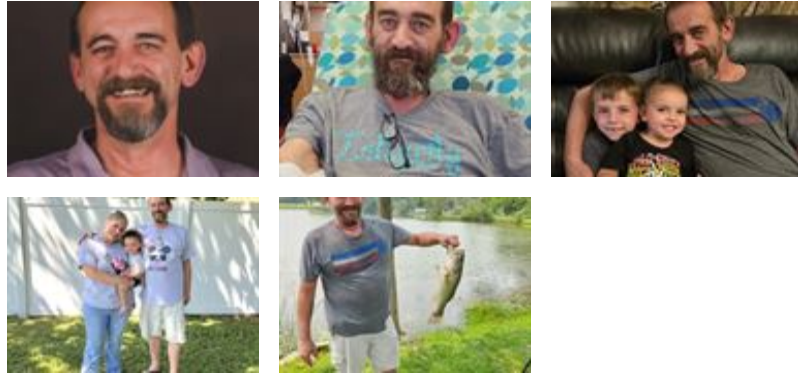
