Nancy J. Schneider, 81, of Pekin, formerly of East Peoria, went to be with her Lord on Wednesday, March 31, 2021 at the OSF Richard L. Owens Hospice Home in Peoria. Nancy was born in Anniston, MO on February 16, 1940 to Donald and Ella (Choate) Bryan. She married Phillip F. Schneider on February 18, 1958 in Hernando, MS. He preceded her in death on July 4, 1992.

Surviving are 2 sons, Rev. Phillip (Renee) Schneider of Bethalto and Jeff (Rhonda) Schneider of Pekin; 6 grandchildren; and 10 great grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by sister, Margaret "Polly" Delaney; brother, Clarence Bryan; and great grandson, Jonah.
